Background

- INTERREG IIIC is constituted of 4 programmes
- Need identified by some running operations
- Will of the EC and Member States
- New procedure proposed to the West Monitoring Committee: to allocate supplementary ERDF to running operations for capitalisation activities



Details on the procedure

- Objective: "To ensure that the results of the INTERREG IIIC operations are maximised and that future operations under the new programme can benefit and build on what has already been achieved"
- How? By sharing and grouping the findings of operations working in similar fields
- Who can apply? All INTERREG IIIC West operations
- Applications through the request for changes procedure (on going procedure)



Details on the procedure

- Type of activities: joint conferences, joint thematic/workshops, study visits, staff exchanges, studies, joint publications
- Capitalisation with other INTERREG IIIC operations and, only in justified cases, with other INTERREG IIIA & B projects
- Decision process: INTERREG IIIC West Steering Committee (SC) decides through written procedure
- Procedure just approved by the West MC (8 September 2006)
