INTRODUCTION

Large scale projects

Large scale projects are identified in the ENPI CBC Implementing rules as projects comprising a set of works, activities or services intended to fulfil an indivisible function of a precise nature pursuing clearly identified objectives of common interest for the purposes of implementing cross-border investments. The Workshop aims at exchanging on the specificities of LSP (incl. their preparation) as well as on different types of infrastructure projects.

6 Programmes have foreseen Large scale projects in Joint Operational Programmes (approx. up to € 170 mln): Latvia-Lithuania-Belarus, Lithuania-Poland-Russia, Poland-Belarus-Ukraine, Hungary-Slovakia-Romania-Ukraine, Romania-Ukraine-Moldova, Black Sea Basin.

Procurement procedures

The design of the ENPI CBC Programmes also enables them to fund large standard projects with infrastructure components. Both LSP and large standard projects with infrastructure components require a significant amount of works, supplies and services to be subcontracted . Thus, the workshop is aiming at exchanging on different challenges in ensuring that the procurement used for this subcontracting is in line with the EC requirements.
