



Why this Group

Share experiences and problems of individual Programs to improve the usability of the system

- After one year of informal dialogue with the National Authority, a better structure was needed;
- The various Managing Authorities started to "wink at the Jems";
- Licence agreement signed;
- Many features and/or problems were common to the various programs (EiDAS, PUC, data extraction, etc)
- By using all the same technological platform, it was possible to maximize costs and times;

Why collaborative requirement gathering

- To have a single and shared vision of all functional and technical requirements;
- To not replicate similar functionality and/or plug-in;
- To avoid flooding the Interact help desk;
- To increase the value and weight of requests presented to the Core Group;



Collaborative Requirement Gathering Approaches

The collaborative approach & the operative methodology

Jems Italian Group adopts the same approach proposed by Interact within the Core, User and thematic Group

 Online meeting every month (2-3 hours of meeting) in proximity of the Core group meetings



- Homework from Interact shared with all programmes
- The topics covered are often in preparation for the Core Group
- 1 or 2 representative per programme

 Physical meeting every 6 months. First meeting on 21 September in Venice hosted by Italy-Croatia Programme



Collaborative Requirement Gathering Approaches

Communication channels

- Google meet for online meeting
- Slack for instant communication. Different spaces by topic
- Google cloud for sharing docs
- Doodle for decisions









Ensuring Representation of All Programme Needs

ITALIAN PROGRAMME NEEDS

- The coordinators of the Italian JEMS group collect the needs of the Programmes which will be discussed during the meetings.
- The goal is to find a solution that can be developed jointly while respecting the timelines of all Programmes (Igrue protocol)

IDENTIFIED NEEDS TO INTERACT

- ► The Italian JEMS GROUP identifies priorities
- CG representatives communicate the group's needs DURING the feature development phase.

Lessons Learnt and Best Practices

An agreement was made between MA to share some solutions including:

- Update of System & Application Translation (in Italian and French)
- Common technical/legal specifications for software suppliers;
- the possibility of having a common middleware on which to develop specific plugins;
- building plugins collaboratively (cost/time sharing)
- periodic test days

Lessons Learnt and Best Practices

• At least 1 person (from each Programme) who knows well program processes (not a developer but a good analyst who understands needs and knows how to transform them into real solutions)

Ability to adapt and imagine possible alternative solutions (costs/benefits)

But most of all

 Remember that there is no software capable of satisfying all imagined needs and requirements

It's not easy... but we try!
