


3 core values, shared by NEB projects and initiatives:



NEB MAINSTREAMING IN COHESION POLICY



Inclusion of the NEB either in Partnership Agreements and Programmes

All Member-States have included commitments to the New European Bauhaus in cohesion policy programmes.

Examples of commitments:

• incorporation of the NEB values in interventions on energy efficiency, or investments in sustainable urban development.

- NEB commitments have also been included in JTF Programmes.
- <u>Specific NEB call</u> planned under the ERDF&JTF in Saxony-Anhalt (Germany).

SUPPORT TO NEW EUROPEAN BAUHAUS LOCAL INITIATIVES (TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CALL)

- 20 place-based projects are receiving technical support on the ground to develop and implement NEB projects.
- Via a Technical Assistance Programme.
- Municipalities with less than 100.000 inhabitants.

Projects in 4 action areas:

- 1) Renovation of existing buildings and public spaces in a spirit of circularity and carbon neutrality;
- 2) Preservation and transformation of cultural heritage;
- 3) Adaptation and transformation of buildings for affordable housing solutions;
- 4) Regeneration of urban or rural spaces.

Type of support:

- 1) Needs assessment
- 2) Project development and planning
- 3) Implementation roadmap


