



Analysis model cross-border added value: 2) Role of the border in the project?

Bridging border barriers

Projects aimed at bridging border barriers; legal, administrative, physical or perceived border barriers.

Border as a resource

Projects that see and exploit cross-border similarities and differences as a necessary resource to create results and joint learning, e.g. knowledge, research, experts, etc.

Critical mass utilization

Projects that use the potential to work across the border as a prerequisite for creating results, e.g. through greater numbers of tourists, companies, students, etc.
