

Delivery Prizes 2021

- Part of the design stage, spotlight on inspirational examples and ideas by young talents
- Close cooperation DG REGIO JRC
- Launched on 23 April https://prizes.new-european-bauhaus.eu/
- Competition: April May 2021, winners announced on 16 Sept.
- 10 categories, two strands:
 - "New European Bauhaus Awards" existing, completed examples
 - "New European Bauhaus Rising Stars" concepts, ideas submitted by young talents (30 age or less)
- New edition in 2022, to be launched in Q1

NEB related calls and DGs involved:

- **DG RTD** launched the Lighthouse demonstration call
- **EIT** launched the call SCALE UP FOR EUROPE The New European Bauhaus Acceleration Pilot Call

NEB beyond Cohesion policy

- **DG GROW** launched the Affordable Housing Initiative
- **EISMEA** launched a call for proposal on "Social economy and local green deals supporting SMEs to become more resilient"
- The **JRC** is broadly informing the community about the opportunities to contribute and become part of the NEB, working with different services on the definition of the NEB related calls announced in the Communication. Among them, there is the NEB Lab.

Communication 573(2021): New European Bauhaus - Beautiful, Sustainable, Together

The European Commission invites Member States to:

- introduce the New European Bauhaus in their socio-economic and territorial development strategies and to reflect their commitment to support and mainstream the New European Bauhaus in the implementation of cohesion policy 2021-2027 as part of the Partnership Agreements and relevant operational programmes;

- take up the New European Bauhaus financial instrument to finance projects on the ground

 mobilise the relevant parts of their recovery and resilience plans (e.g. on renovation or infrastructures) on New European Bauhaus transformative projects.
