





- All programme rules regarding legal status, obligations and eligibility apply to a sub-partner as well.





ADVANTAGES OF BEING A SUB-PARTNER

Simplified administrative requirements!


- A sub-partner does not need its own **authorised signatory**
- A sub-partner does not need its own **controller**
- Both the **finance and the activity reports** can be prepared by the sub-partner OR by the (coordinating) partner




