Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme

✓ Approved in August 2022 – Budget **179 M EUR** ERDF

Programme vision is to focus on **blue economy**, **capitalising** previous cooperation experiences and creating **stronger synergies with EUSAIR**

- ✓ 5 priorities:
- 1 Sustainable growth in the blue economy
- 2 Green and resilient shared environment
- 3 Sustainable maritime and multimodal transport
- 4 Culture and tourism for sustainable development
- 5 Integrated governance for stronger cooperation





Our strategy in terms of synergies and complementarities (1)

The Interreg Italy-Croatia Programme wants to "establish structured **inter-programme coordination among Interreg Programmes** financing operations in the same cooperation area" (IP chapter 1.2)


On this basis:

- ✓ We have been participating, since 2021, to the "**Med Lab community**" organized by Interact to improve synergies across the Mediterranean (several events held online, one event onsite held in March 2023 in Dubrovnik)
- ✓ We contributed to the **EUSAIR Action Labs** exercise organized by the Italian National Authority in the programming phase → useful to develop our OSI projects contributing to EUSAIR flagships
- ✓ We looked at existing initiatives in the Mediterranean Area to test possible coordination activities



Our strategy in terms of synergies and complementarities (2)

✓ We invited other instruments and Programmes in 3 events organized with stakeholders and beneficiaries by our Programme in the last year:

Our strategy in terms of synergies and complementarities (3)

✓ We made contacts with representatives of the "Multi-Programme Coordination Mechanism in the Mediterranean Sea Basin" (NEXT MED, Euro-MED, Italy-France Maritime) and took part in the onsite joint event organized in Florence in May 2023, together with other Programmes

Capitalisation plan activities

- 1 Establishment of specific criteria for selection of outputs based on the principle of reuse and transfer
- 2 Drafting methodological paper for the production of quality outputs
- 3 Organization of capitalisation workshops
- 4 Guiding LPs in the publication of content in the digital library according to the type of outputs/deliverables
- 5 Integration of a capitalisation section in the Standard projects proposals Application Form and Project report
- 6 Revision of methodological paper for the production of quality outputs
- 7 Revision of the specific criteria for selection of outputs based on the principle of reuse and transfer
- 8 Integration of a capitalisation guidance into LP seminar
- Integration of a capitalisation requirement in the OSI projects proposals Application Form (set up their own capitalisation plan) and Project Report
- 10 Embedding (and updating) the digital library/catalogue into the Programme website
- 11 Ad hoc Programme support to Associated Partners in capitalisation (reuse of outputs)
- 12 Identification/Mapping of 'Takers'/network leaders
- 13 Involvement of MC members in the identification of 'Takers'
- 14 Set up the communication strategy towards the 'Takers'
- 15 Have a targeted communication strategy towards 'Takers'
- Join the Pilot Multi-programme Coordination Mechanism in the Mediterranean Sea Basin on sustainable tourism
- 20 Participation in initiatives/events with other programmes/at national and/or EU level




Multi-Programme Coordination Mechanism

- ✓ The Mechanism wants to contribute to the embedding of current and future strategies in the Mediterranean, stemming from the request of the Commission to improve complementarity and synergies between Interreg programmes
- ✓ A pilot was carried out on in 2022/2023 on a topic transversal to all policy objectives: **sustainable tourism** in its wider understanding has been identified as a first specific field of experimentation, while new fields of implementation could be embedded
- ✓ Link to capitalisation activities is underlined and focus on results achieved is central
- ✓ The governance of the Mechanism foresees a light but structured coordination that, while respecting the governance and operational prerogatives of each Programme, encourages a reinforced collaboration and the achievement of common goals

Our expectations

Reinforcing our capitalization activities

Set of common criteria for identification of GOOD outputs (e.g.):

- ✓ New models of monitoring and/or management interventions/solutions
- ✓ new support for policy development (if any...);
- √ high potential level of communication added value;
- ✓ advanced state of achievement, replicability, transferability and sustainability

Joint work with takers/ re-users of outputs

Critical mass towards the **EU institutions**

Easier to address and engage (common) beneficiaries and stakeholders





Next steps

- ✓ In **December 2023 a meeting** is planned to discuss the action plan for 2024
- ✓ There is a proposal to present this action plan (once defined and endorsed by MCs) to the **European Commission in Brussels in 2024** (unofficially already illustrated in Santiago by the 3 founding members)
- ✓ Ad hoc **communication actions** will be jointly carried out and sustained by the different Programmes through their TA and/or ISO1 activities (joint events, videos, infographics, etc.)
- ✓ We discussed about proposing a workshop on synergies at the next EU Week of Regions and Cities in October 2024
- ✓ Ambition to coordinate **Calls for Proposals** focusing on capitalization of results in the second part of the programming period (probably 2026)





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
