
7 tips to help the projects

- 1. Explain the basic rules in plain language
- 2. Repeat again and again and again

1. Explain the rules in plain language

- Explain in simple terms
- Translate to local language/s
- Warning about financial corrections
- Illustrate key points
- Recommend consultations



2. Repeat the rules again and again

Repetitio est mater studiorum

- Rules in the Call for proposals
- Rules in the Implementation Manual
- Rules in the contract
- Rules at all training events
- Rules on the website, social media, email, phone, fax, smoke signals, etc.



3. Lead by examples

- Collects and share examples
- SHOW them how it should be done
- Inspire with your visibility actions
- Quality universal banners
- Appropriate promo materials



4. JS project managers as allies

- Most contact with projects
- Help them recognize potential problems
- Referral for consultations
- Joint project visits



5. JS communication officer approval

- Recognize the knowledge of your communication experts
- Projects can ask for approval
- Risky projects can be obliged to get approval



6. Templates

- Billboards, posters, stickers, etc.
- Universal roll-up solutions
- Templates work best on the programme level
- Make them easy to adjust
- Vector format files



7. Communication kick-off set

- Posters and stickers are cheap
- Use a template and print posters for all approved projects
- Universal co-funding stickers
- At the awarding ceremony, give each project a communication kick-off set
