How we will work...

Step 1

Choose your table

Step 2

At your table vote on the order of topics discussed – dotting exercise (3 dots) – you will have 40 minutes to discuss all topics; We discuss a topic after a topic!

Step 3

How do we discuss a topic?

- 1) Each participants 4 posts-its for each topic - to reply on (if relevant):
 - the novelty that works the best for my programme;
 - what do we need more/ what is still missing?;
 - what do we need less (stumble blocks)?;
 - lessons learned; mistakes to avoid ?;
- 2) Discuss the answers;
- 3) Agree on max two priorities per topic that will make the biggest impact for the future;

How we will work...

Step 4

Rotate. Extra 20 minutes

The participants who will join during the second round can contribute by leaving their post-its but only for two the most important in their opinion topics and commenting on the chosen priorities (leaving the agree/disagree post-it).

Step 5

Facilitators report to the plenary on the priorities

Step 6

Joint discussion and first reflections on priorities
